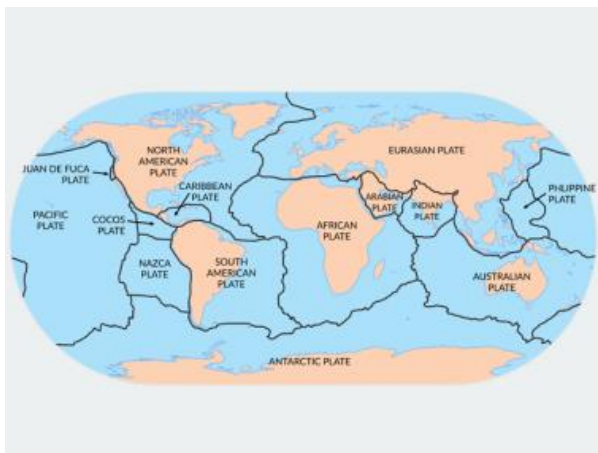

Year 5: Geography – Australia, New Zealand and the South Pacific

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Continent	Any of the world's main continuous expanses of land.
States	A nation or territory considered as an organised political community under one government.
Indigenous	Originating or occurring naturally in a particular place.
Transportation	The action or practice of transporting convicts to a penal colony.
Volcano	A mountain, typically conical, having a crater or vent through which lava, rock fragments, hot vapour and gas are or have been erupted from the earth's crust.
Lava	Hot molten or semi-fluid rock erupted from a volcano.
Hot Springs	A spring of naturally hot water, typically heated by subterranean volcanic activity.
Tectonic	Relating to the structure of the earth's crust and the large scale processes which happen to it.
Moai	Monolithic (single stone) human figures carved on Easter Island.
