Key Vocabulary	Definition
Roman Empire	A huge empire, controlled by Rome, lasting between 509 BCE and 476 CE.
Republic	A government where the people are in charge rather than the king.
Latin	The language of Rome, spoken across the Roman Empire.
The class system	The order of importance for different people in Roman society.
Agrimensore	A person who planned Roman roads.
Decempeda	A Roman measuring stick.
Groma	A tool that Romans used to see how straight the roads were.
Plebeians	These people were the working class.
Patricians	The people who were at the top of Roman society.
Aqueduct	A stone trough to carry water across the country into Roman towns.
