Draw or make our solar system.	Draw and label a diagram of the Earth's layers.	Design a rocket to visit another planet. Label the features.
Research star constellations. Draw or write about your favourite.	Draw a map and label the countries of the British Isles.	Draw the flags of the countries of the British Isles.
Find out about the capital cities of the British Isles. Record facts in writing.	Surprise us! You can do anything as long as it is linked to astronomy or the British Isles.	Write a postcard from one of the countries of the British Isles.

We would also encourage your child to continue to use TT Rockstars and Spelling Shed. Children should be reading and practising spellings every day. Spellings will come home on a Monday, they will be tested the following Monday. An overview of the spellings for this term can be found in your child's reading record. Please encourage your child to spot the pattern and research other words that also follow the same pattern. Results will be recorded on the overview sheet.
