Word building and reading

New Sounds and Spelling : n, p, o

Using a, i, m, n, o, p, s, t cut up the sounds and ask your child to make the following words.

Then play sound swap using a, i, m, n, o, p, s, t. Ask your child to make the first word - sat. Then ask what sound they need to swap to make the word sit. Say sat very clearly and slowly. Repeat for these words
pit→pin→tin→tan→pan→pat→mat→man→map→mop→top→tap→sip

Please keep this activity and keep practising it as often as possible and write a note in your child's reading diary to let us know how they get on with it.
