This term's homework will be based on our new topics of **History – Benin Kingdom, Geography – Slums and Science – Light, Earth & Space**

Below you will find the grid of homework tasks. We would like you to choose **one a week** to complete. When you have completed a task you will get a dojo point. There will be 5 dojo points available for homework that shows great effort or achievement. We are expecting 6 tasks to be completed before the end of term; you may choose which ones you complete. The core knowledge sheets can be found on the school website and will also be displayed on the class window.

Design a poster encouraging people to 'Save Our Planet'.	Make a model or draw a picture of a planet.	Research / produce some Benin Art.
Make an information leaflet about how the planets orbit the sun.	Write a diary entry about living in a slum.	Research Palm Oil and what it is used for. Is it still in use today?
Write a letter to the British Empire to try to prevent a war between you.	Take a walk around what you would consider to be your area – can you see anything you may also find in a slum?	Research what types of crime occur in slums and explain why.

We would also encourage your child to continue to use TT Rockstars. Children should be reading and practising spellings every day. Weekly Spellings will come home on a Tuesday, they will be tested the following Tuesday and the 100 Year 5/6 common exception words will be tested once a term.
