

## Year 6 homework project – Autumn 1

For the first half term we have chosen some project-based homework tasks for you to complete **in addition** to practising your spellings, common exception words and TT rockstars. For each homework task completed you will receive **1 dojo point**. For any work that shows extra effort and care, you will receive **5 dojo points**.

The final due date for this half term is Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October.

You may choose how you present each piece, you may take plain or lined paper home from school if you need to.

### Tasks:

Build a launcher rocket. What did you do? How did you do it? Choose how to present your work.	Research one of Andy Warhol's art pieces and recreate it yourself.	Think about what you have read in 'The Hounds of the Baskervilles'. Draw what you imagine the hound to look like.
Do some baking! Choose a new recipe you haven't made before and make it with someone at home. Write the recipe up neatly to share with the class. Maybe you can include some pictures of your masterpiece?	Read a new book and write a detailed book review about it. Include a brief summary of the plot and main characters, explain who the book is aimed at (children, teens, adults) and why, and tell us whether you would recommend it and why.	Create a design for a board game that would help someone to practise their methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in Year 5 and 6. You do not have to make it; you could just explain what it would look and how to play.
Ask your friends and family to make a list of any song titles that have space themed words in them. Choose one to listen to, create a mindmap about it. In the mindmap include the instruments you can hear and how the music makes you feel.	Research a humanist thinker. What did they believe? What/who influenced them? Were there any significant moments in their life? Choose how to present your work.	Explore points of interest in the local area. Bring if photographs or pictures you have drawn.

Please ensure you are still practising your spellings weekly, and also practising TT rockstars each week as often as possible.
