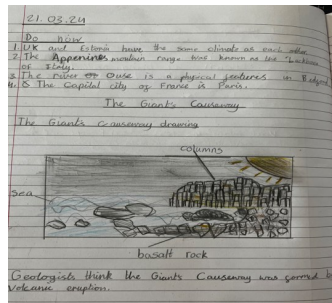
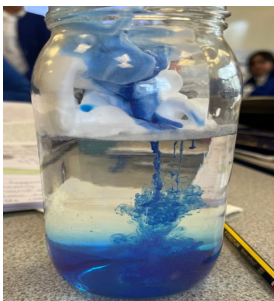


Year4
